

ELDERSLIE HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS STAGE 4 (Years 7-8) 2024-2025



<u>AIM</u>: The aims of offering a scholarship are to:

- **Promote the image** of Elderslie High School in the wider community as a quality school with an extensive curriculum and extra curricula activities.
- Attract to the school <u>high achieving and motivated students</u> to add value and excellence to our school.
- **Enhance** the overall performance obtained by the school.
- Assist quality students who need <u>financial</u> support.

DETAILS:

Each year, a range of Stage 4 (Years 7-8) Scholarships will be offered in areas for which the school has an established reputation. The focus of the scholarships may change each year.

For 2024, the 5 areas in which scholarships will be awarded are Creative and Performing Arts, Sport, Academic, Leadership and Citizenship.

The scholarship covers the students costs for:

- 1. School contributions and course charges (as listed on the Year 7 or Year 8 school fee sheet)
- 2. Day excursion costs for Years 7 8.

The value of each scholarship will vary but is worth approximately \$500-\$600 (over the two year period of the scholarship). The scholarship will not cover weekly (school or grade) sport costs; camps; or extracurricular activities that are not associated with the area of expertise. It may however cover some of the costs associated with Regional or State representation (in area of expertise) should the student be selected.

EXPECTATION: In return, the school expects the scholarship holder to:

- participate in school activities that align to their area of expertise e.g. carnivals, musicals, SRC, subject competitions, ensemble groups, choir, public speaking;
- comply with school rules and uniform code at all times;
- continue to perform to their personal best; and
- maintain outstanding grades and marks if awarded an academic scholarship.
- maintain his/her enrolment at Elderslie High School over the two year period for which the scholarship has been awarded

SELECTION PROCESS:

- 1. Primary Principals must support and sign each application.
- 2. Applications are submitted on the appropriate form (attached) by the due date and a panel will convene to short list the candidates.
- 3. The faculty for which the scholarship applies then <u>selects</u> (this may be by audition, writing task, review of achievements, etc.) the successful applicant. Where <u>financial assistance</u> is declared and verified this would be a factor in the final decision.
- 4. The successful candidates will be required to attend the Annual Elderslie High School Presentation Ceremony on 14th December 2023 at which the scholarship will be presented.
- 5. The scholarship is reviewed annually to ensure expectations are being met.
